





# Community Pharmacy – Better access to healthcare information for you and your patients

By the end of 2018, every Australian will have a My Health Record unless they choose not to have one.

My Health Record is designed to equip community pharmacists with the additional information needed to improve patient care, especially during transition of care (from the community to the hospital and vice versa) when medication errors are most likely to occur.

Pharmacists can access a range of clinical information in a patient's My Health Record, including information about medicines, allergies, immunisations, pathology results and medical conditions.

Pharmacists are encouraged to integrate the use of the My Health Record system into patient care, where appropriate.

# What patients can expect when logging into **My Health Record** for the first time

The first time your patients log into their My Health Record there may be little, or no information in it. There may be up to two years' worth of Medicare information such as doctor visits under the Medicare Benefits Schedule (MBS), as well as their Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (PBS) claim history. If they choose to, your patients can remove this information after they log in. Previous medical history such as older tests and medical reports will not be in their My Health Record.



### **Benefits for patients**

#### My Health Record allows:

- access to medicines information
- access to uploaded health information
- better support and care coordination, especially for patients with chronic and complex conditions
- recording of patient-entered information such as medicines purchased over-the-counter in their personal health summary
- better engagement with their own healthcare and healthcare providers
