

Medical Director: Installing NASH Certificate

This factsheet provides instructions on installing your NASH Certificate into Medical Director.

Before getting started:

A National Authentication Service for Health (NASH) Public Key Infrastructure (PKI) Certificate, issued by the Department of Human Services is used to allow health care providers to securely access and share health information, this includes My Health Record.

Ensure you have requested and downloaded your NASH certificate from PRODA. This <u>step by step</u> <u>guide</u> will assist you. Save it to a location you will remember. You will need to access this location. The NASH PKI Certificate will be available for download and installing for a period of 30 days from issue.

Please note: NASH certificates must be installed on the server.

- 1. Save NASH certificate file from PRODA onto your server.
- 2. In Medical Director, under Tools select Options.



3. Select *PKI* tab and *Import Certificate*. Please note, you must have administrator access to perform this import.

- 5. Click the "..." to locate the NASH Certificate file **(FAC_Sign.p12)**. You will be returned to the Import Certificate window.
- 6. Enter the password for the NASH Certificate. This is the PIC code sent as an SMS message when you requested your certificate.
- 7. Click *Import,* and then *Save* on the options window.
