Uploading an Event Summary

Note:

These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient's Individual Healthcare Identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system, and the patient has a My Health Record.

- Once you have opened the patient's local medical record and entered the clinical information/notes for the consultation, select the MyHealthRecord tab to gain access to the patient's My Health Record.
- 2. In the My Health Record View tab, select Create Clinical Document (bottom-left corner).
- 3. In the e-Heath tab, double-click on CDA Event Summary or highlight it and select OK.
- 4. Select Import Progress Notes to populate the Clinical Synopsis box. The Synopsis can also be entered/edited manually.
 - Tick/untick the items to include/not include in the Event Summary, then select the Send to My Health Record icon (top-left corner).
 - With the **More** buttons you can also import information already saved in the patient's local medical record.
