# Profiles SA3 report

### Introduction

In order to use and interpret this data appropriately it is important to be aware of some of the limitations.

Much of the data is pulled from the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) census datapacks for 2021. Some adjustments have been made dependent on the data from each of these datapacks. When data from the ABS is broken down to lower levels their practice is to add and subtract random variances to avoid identification. Thus, when adding all of these lower level cells there will be a difference to using the high level data.

### **Total population**

The total population is derived by adding the 'persons' data for each Indigenous status together for all the age groups from the Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander datapacks. This will be a slight variation to a total figure that is pulled directly from the general Community Profile datapack (e.g. G01).

### **Health conditions**

For the health condition data, the '1 or more health condition' data point has been <u>created</u> by subtracting the 'None' or 'Not Stated' from the population for this group rather than using the census data point of '1 selected health condition'. The '1 or more health condition' utilised here therefore depicts a more accurate picture of the population with a long-term health condition as it encompasses the 'Other' option.

## When to use this dashboard

The intention of this dashboard is to provide a 2 page interactive profile for either a single SA3 or a group of SA3 regions. The data is publicly available and is from the most current period available, unless otherwise specified. There is an alternative Profiles SA3 Power BI report which is interactive.
